- 9 Centre Manager's Report**
Kevin Lobley gave details of changes to the Reception Area Improvement Plan. The main change being the removal of safety glass. The width of the counter would give sufficient staff protection. The changes were welcomed by the staff. It was agreed to allow the changes to the plan.
